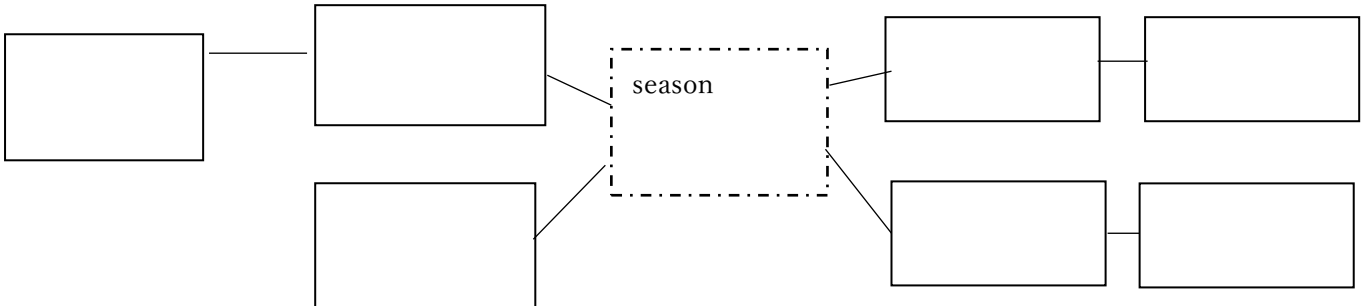


6年生 「春はあけぼの」
